Senior Canine Program Consent Form

As dogs age, we know that they, like people, have a greater risk for developing certain diseases and conditions. For example, we know that the incidence of problems such as heart disease, kidney disease, arthritis, and oral/dental disease increases with advancing age. However, such diseases, when detected in their early stages, can be treated and their progress slowed in some cases.

For that reason, we recommend that all of our canine patients that are seven years of age or older, have an annual geriatric evaluation. This evaluation includes a complete and thorough physical exam, a complete blood count (CBC), blood chemistry profile (General Health Profile) and urinalysis. As in all health evaluations, early detection is the key as it allows for better treatment options.
