

# What Type of Dental is best for your Pet?

We have two types of Dentals here at loving Touch Animal Center, an Anesthetic and a Non-Anesthetic. The Traditional Anesthetic dental involves sedating the dog or cat and cleaning their teeth. The other way is a Non- Anesthetic dental. In that method a Dental Technician takes the dog or cat and cleans their teeth while they are awake. Both options are effective, it just depends on what is better for your pet.

## **Non-Anesthetic Dental**

### **PROS**

- 1. Clean Teeth!
- 2. Does not require Bloodwork
- 3. Does not use any anesthetic, so it's a great option for older pets and pets with health issues that can't be sedated.
- 4. Cost \$200.00 (\$250.00 if light sedation is needed)
- Time saver! Pets are done in 30-45 minutes.

#### CONS

1. Dental cannot be done on pets that bite or if they need teeth extractions.

## **Regular Anesthetic Dental**

#### **PROS**

- 1. Clean Teeth!
- Good for pets that need extractions, or for reasons Non-Anesthetic Dental cannot be done.
- 3. Clean under the gums
- 4. Measure all the pockets around the teeth
- 5. Antibiotics are used in case of infections.
- 6. Check for masses in throat
- 7. X-Ray mouth if needed

## **CONS**

- 1. Bloodwork Required
- 2. There are risks with anesthesia
- 3. Cost \$600.00-\$700.00
